There were also reflections gathered from Macy Joanna and Chris Johnstone book, "Active Hope"

The important points of this talk were:

- 1. Shift the focus from outcome to process
- 2. *Spiral that restores our connection with the web of life and with one another:*

Coming from Gratitude
Honouring our pain in the world
Seeing with new eyes
Going forth

The afternoon conference continued **the Spiritual Conversation** with many practical points on how to conduct Active listening and Sharing in the Chapter, before the Sunday Eucharistic celebration.
